

General's Service Uniform Belt with a Shoulder Strap, dated 1979.

In brown leather with a "cut-out star" buckle in gilded brass. The buckle is of the late model featuring the Soviet state emblem. Belts of this type were authorized exclusively for generals and manufactured to the highest quality standard. The shoulder strap matches the belt perfectly and is clearly original to it.

XXL size: the belt measures 58" in overall length. When fully extended using the factory-made holes, it will fit up to about 52" waist and can be adjusted to the size as small as 46"; if desired, extra holes can be made to extend it by about 2 inches or to fit almost any smaller waist size.

Excellent, near mint condition, apparently never used and showing only a storage age. The leather is perfectly "healthy" and supple, free of any noticeable wear or scuffs. The brass of the buckle is very bright and completely free of oxidation or dings. This is really a superb example of the Soviet general's belt from the late Cold War / Afghan War era - literally impossible to upgrade.
