



Memorial Plaque with a Bas-Relief Portrait of Young Stalin, in original fitted presentation case, circa 1950s.

In gypsum with paint coating, 62 mm in diameter. The bas-relief was done off one of photos of young Stalin. A small metal loop on the back allows to hang the plaque on a wall. The inscription on the lid of the case, in Georgian and Russian, reads "I.V. Stalin in 1905." The case is made of sturdy cardboard laminated with leatherette. The fitted space inside is padded and lined with burgundy colored silk. The lid inside is also lined with silk.

In very good to excellent condition, showing just a few minor scuffs to the high points of the bas-relief and a couple of tiny chips to the coating on the back. The lid of the case is minimally warped, not obvious or detractive, the leatherette covering shows no wear of any kind.

Please note that the penny in our photo is for size reference.
