

Achievement Certificate issued on 11 March 1909 to Paraskeva Savchenko (Параскева Георгиевна Савченко), student of a private elementary school, for exemplary academic results and conduct.

Measures 11 1/2" x 9", printed on heavy-stock coated paper. The centerpiece of the decorative frame is the two-headed eagle of the Russian Empire, with portraits of Emperor Nicholas II and his wife, Empress Alexandra Fyodorovna on either side of the emblem. Further down, the frame contains portraits of the greatest luminaries of Russian literature. It is a very well thought-through design carrying a clear and meaningful message to a student receiving this citation. The text of the citation states that Paraskeva Savchenko, a third-year student of G. Savchenko's elementary school is awarded with this citation for exemplary conduct and excellent academic results in the 1908 school year. The citation is dated 11 March 1909 and is signed by the Chairman of the Examination Committee, the Bible class teacher, the classroom teacher, and the school owner, Georgiy Savchenko. Yes, the father of our illustrious student.

In very good condition. The paper is mildly and evenly age-toned and shows a bit of foxing, more pronounced on the verso. The citation has been stored folded in two, and shows small separations at the top and bottom, easily repairable with library tape, if desired.
