

Order of the Red Banner of Labor, Type 6, Variation 2, #1097168, circa mid- to late 1970s issue.

Silver gilt, enamels; measures 47.2 mm tall (incl. the eyelet), 36.6 mm wide. Riveted three-piece construction. The serial number is engraved with a rotating tool. Manufactured in 1976 at the Moscow Mint.

Excellent condition. The enamel retains a beautiful luster throughout and has only a few tiny contact marks on the banner that are barely noticeable to the unaided eye, otherwise perfect.

The fire gilt finish is completely intact and bright. Beautifully pristine stippling and attractive light toning on the reverse. Comes on an original suspension, a two-layer model. The old, probably original ribbon is perfectly preserved and clean. The connecting link appears to be original; its ends are still joined with solder.
