



Austria-Hungary, House of Habsburg, Silver Token (Jetton), Coronation of Hungarian King Leopold II in Pressburg, 15 November 1790.

In silver, 24.9 mm wide, weighs 4.8 g including the custom-made eyelet. Suspended from a threaded ribbon in dark burgundy moiré silk. The obverse is inscribed with the motto PIETATE ET CONCORDIA in Latin. The reverse is inscribed with the following, also in Latin: LEOPOLDVS II D G ROM IMP S A GER HVN BOH REX ARCHID AVSTRIAE CORONATVS POSONII XV NOV MDCCXC.

In very fine to excellent condition. Both sides of the token exhibit very attractive dark patina emphasizing the relief of the emblem and lettering. The custom-made eyelet blends in rather well and does not stand out. A few minor scratches and the uneven disc of the token, as well as some of the oxidation of the suspension ring that has transferred to the silk of the ribbon, add to the aged look of the jetton.
